

Golf Tournament Raises \$300,000 For Domestic Violence Shelters

The Aliso Viejo-based New Home Company donated more than \$300,000 to Interval House, an organization offering shelters for domestic violence victims, at a Nov. 30 ceremony.

The money was raised from an October golf tournament held in Mission Viejo.

Larry Webb, New Home's CEO, estimated more than \$2 million has been raised for Interval House since the golf tournament began more than 20 years ago. He got involved with the organization after helping to build a shelter.

"I walk away always inspired," he said. "The men and women of Interval House are heroes."

Unlike some grants Interval House receives, the New Home funds are not earmarked for a specific cause.

"We felt it was important for them to make the decision on what the best use of the money is," Webb said.

Interval House opened in 1979 and offers services in Los Angeles and Orange counties.
